hile FamilyForward was in no way anticipating a pandemic, we were prepared to support our community through a crisis thanks to you. Our staff worked tirelessly to stay connected to the people we serve and help them overcome barriers. At the same time, inquiries for services increased and we were there to answer the calls. FamilyForward was not only able to persevere, we were able to help even more people. Between March 1 and October 31, we served nearly 3,000 individuals and gave them the guidance they needed to navigate the journey forward.

The effects of COVID-19 continue to devastate so many of our neighbors, adding stress to already difficult situations. FamilyForward walks alongside struggling families on their journey, so tipping points don't become breaking points.



"My family coach has really helped me and my children. She supported me through my pregnancy to make sure my baby has a healthy start and is always giving me new ideas to utilize for my family. She even drove over with a trunk full of diapers, wipes, sanitizer, toilet paper, and laundry detergent. We really needed the supplies because of COVID and being able to see her and wave from the porch made us all smile."



"My advocate is very respectful and a wonderful person. She's more than a teacher, she's a friend who was there for me when I needed to leave my abusive relationship. She's concerned about me and also brought my daughter a laptop for virtual school. I've received valuable help and support."



"Our therapist has gone above and beyond to support our son Colin during the pandemic. She made and delivered a home play therapy kit we can use during our telehealth sessions and other times as a family. We speak openly and she is a source of constant encouragement and understanding. FamilyForward has compassion for Colin, as well as us as parents."




CREATING JOYFUL MOMENTS

Their Eating Smart • Being Active course has adapted to be hybrid, so participants can be together for virtual classes and also have safe, one-on-one cooking lessons with the instructor.

Sharée's client really enjoyed her experience with SLUIC and plans to use her new knowledge and skills to keep her family healthy and create a nurturing environment for her baby.


